'Professor Robson and Dr McMullen both bring a wealth of experience across the acute and primary care sectors and SHPA looks forward to continuing to work together with the AMA to improve the quality, capacity and sustainability of Australia's healthcare system.

'SHPA has supported the AMA's recent campaign to "Clear the Hospital Logjam", as ambulance ramping, long waiting lists for surgeries and crowded emergency departments have contributed to a deterioration in safety and the quality of care doctors and pharmacists are able to provide when patients need critical hospital care.

'Doctors and pharmacists work together each day to enhance the quality and safety of care, with collaborative initiatives such as Partnered Pharmacist Medication Charting allowing doctors to spend more time with patients directly. In this spirit, we look forward to exploring further ways in which doctors and pharmacists can unite to support system capacity.'

Mr Fowler also thanked Dr Omar Khorshid and Dr Chris Moy for their leadership over the last two years.
