## Pharmaceutical Benefits Scheme (PBS) – esomeprazole 40 mg for complex gastro-oesophageal reflux disease (GORD)

## Did you know?

Esomeprazole 40 mg enteric tablets and capsules for the treatment of complex gastro-oesophageal reflux disease (GORD) can only be prescribed as a PBS-subsided authority medicine by the listed specialists, either a:

- gastroenterologist; or
- surgeon with expertise in the upper gastrointestinal tract.

General Practitioners (GPs) and other prescribers cannot write PBS-subsidised prescriptions for esomeprazole 40 mg tablets/capsules for complex GORD. Do not refer patients to another prescriber to request these prescriptions as the authority request will be rejected.

There are other proton pump inhibitors used to treat complex GORD that can be prescribed by the patient's GP in consultation with one of the above mentioned specialists.

To obtain authority approval to prescribe PBS-subsidised esomeprazole 40 mg, requests can be made in 'real time' using the Online PBS Authorities (OPA) system (the system). The system makes it easier for you to request an authority approval from Services Australia by providing an immediate processing response.

From 1 September 2024, where the patient's condition is stable and the nominated specialist considers a 60-day prescription is suitable for the patient, that specialist can apply for authority prescription approval for a quantity of 60 days' supply with 5 repeats, providing 12 months' supply on one prescription. To assist with the process, it is important to familiarise yourself with the relevant PBS restriction available on pbs.gov.au.
