Shortage of SEPTRIN sugar-free oral liquid, trimethoprim 40 mg/5 mL and sulfamethoxazole 200 mg/5 mL, 100 mL bottle and alternative supply arrangement under Section 19A of the Therapeutic Goods Act

Dear Healthcare Professional,

This communication is sent by ORSPEC Pharma to notify your organisation that due to the shortage of SEPTRIN sugar-free oral liquid, trimethoprim 40 mg/5 mL and sulfamethoxazole 200 mg/5 mL, 100 mL bottle (AUST R 11000), ORSEPC Pharma has arranged the supply of an alternative product on a temporary basis.

NOPIL FUR KINDER SIRUP (sulfamethoxazole and trimethoprim 200 mg/40 mg oral syrup 100 mL bottle), is NOT registered in Australia and supply is granted under an exemption granted by the Therapeutic Goods Administration (TGA) under Section 19A of the Therapeutic Goods Act, 1989 until 30 November 2023.

NOPIL FUR KINDER SIRUP (sulfamethoxazole and trimethoprim 200 mg/40 mg oral syrup 100 mL bottle) is approved for use under Section 19A for the following indications:

Upper and lower respiratory tract infections; renal and urinary tract infections; genital tract infections; gastrointestinal tract infections; skin and wound infections; septicaemias, and other infections caused by sensitive organisms.

## Note to the dispensing pharmacist:

Please provide a copy of the Australian **SEPTRIN sugar-free oral liquid** CMI available at <a href="https://www.ebs.tga.gov.au/">https://www.ebs.tga.gov.au/</a> with each dispensing of **NOPIL FUR KINDER SIRUP** (**sulfamethoxazole and trimethoprim 200 mg/40 mg oral syrup 100 mL bottle**).

The following information is in German language on the packaging. To ensure patients/carers use and store the product correctly, please include the following information to the dispensing label:

- "Shake before use"
- "Store between 15-25 °C in a dry place"
- "Discard within 4 weeks of opening"

Please note the following differences in excipients between **SEPTRIN sugar-free oral liquid bottle - ARTG 11000** and **NOPIL FUR KINDER SIRUP** to be supplied under section 19A (referred as the S19A products below).

The strength 'sulfamethoxazole 200 mg/5 mL and trimethoprim 40 mg/5 mL' are clearly distinguishable in the English language.
