Gilead PACE Grant (Pharmacy Advancing Clinical Excellence)

Supporting TRANSLATIONAL RESEARCH in the areas of Cancer Pharmacy and/or Infectious Diseases Pharmacy

GILEAD

Since its inception in 1987, Gilead's focus has been to advance therapeutics against life-threatening diseases worldwide.

A grant of \$40,000 (inc GST) will be made available.

A two-step competitive process for application will be required, beginning with an EOI outlining the research proposal. The National Translational Research Collaborative (NTRC) will then shortlist. Selected applicants will then be invited to submit a detailed application for further consideration by the NTRC.

Areas of focus:

- A Project that focuses on patient outcomes and is translational in nature
- May be a pilot but may lend itself to future scale-up
- Will demonstrate linkages with other professional and patient groups (e.g. consumer groups)
- NTRC will be directly involved in grant recipient selection
- Be able to be completed within 18 months
- Be an inter-professional research group but one or more of the primary investigators must have a minimum of 2 years current membership with SHPA

Application Criteria:

- Applications for funding will not be considered if the research has commenced or concluded at the time of the grant closing date
- · Applications will not be considered from previous grant recipients who have grant reports outstanding
- Research must be commenced within 12 months of notification of a successful application
- A complete list of general and mandatory conditions for grant applicants is available at the SHPA website
- Applications must be completed using the SHPA Research 'Expression of Interest' form (copies of the form are available from the Federal Secretariat Office of the SHPA or the SHPA website).
