

EDUCATION PATHWAY DESCRIPTORS

Foundation

Educational offerings at Foundation level are suited to pharmacists who are developing their practice in the therapeutic or skills area on offer. This may include those who are interested in a new practice area, those pharmacist's early post-registration or pharmacists newly employed in the hospital setting.

Pharmacists who are further along their career pathway may still find offerings of value to them at the Foundation level.

Small group learning at this level (e.g. case study sessions) will have a tutor: participant ratio of 1:15.

Extension

Offerings at Extension level are aimed at those pharmacists who are looking to extend or consolidate their practice in a therapeutic or skills area and often follow on from Foundation level offerings.

This may include pharmacists who are more established practitioners in a specialist area, those in their second year of the SHPA General Residency Program or those considering or starting a specialist residency.

Small group learning at this level (e.g. case study sessions) will have a tutor: participant ratio of 1:15.

Masterclass

Masterclass offerings are suited to pharmacists with a significant level of specialist skill and knowledge in a therapeutic area.

This may include pharmacists who are considered specialists in their given therapeutic area or those who are specialist generalists. Pharmacists involved in their final year of a specialist residency are also likely to find these offerings relevant.

Small group learning at this level (e.g. case study sessions) will have a tutor: participant ratio of 1:10.
