# Acknowledgements

The story of Advanced Pharmacy Australia's **Reflect Reconciliation Action Plan**, highlights the values of community, collaboration and *yindyamarra*, a Wiradjuri term that encompasses respect, honour and responsibility.

In naming this document *Yindyamarra 2030*, we seek to imbue this concept through all that we do while celebrating Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander peoples as the first pharmacists of Australia, bush medicine practitioners and doctors who practised on this land.

We acknowledge Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander people as the Traditional Owners of the lands and waterways on which all Australians meet, work and live, and thank their elders past and present.

## Use of *yindyamarra*

AdPha's Reconciliation Action Plan artwork was created by Chrystel Galea, an Indigenous woman from the Wiradjuri Nation now living on the land of the Kirrae Whurrong people, Eastern Maar, in rural Victoria. Chrystel describes that in her artwork *Smoking Ceremony* 'a bundle of decorated Eucalyptus leaves, emerging from a smoky background, are surrounded by more symbols of community, communication and respect, all of which reinforce the importance of the values of *yindyamarra*.'

We thank and acknowledge Chrystel and her Elders for use of 'yindyamarra' in this document, a Wiradjuri word and way of thinking.

## What is Yindyamarra 2030?

*Yindyamarra 2030* is the forward vision for advanced pharmacy in Australia, spanning three horizons: Equity 2025-26, Sustainability 2027-28 and Adaptability 2029-2030.

This document details goals under five pillars: Workforce, Patient Care, Learn and Grow, Govern and Sustain, which evolve through each horizon to ensure a more inclusive, connected, collaborative and sustainable pharmacy community in 2030.

Not included in the strategic plan, but underpinning all activity, is progression through Reconciliation Action Plans to ensure AdPha supports First Nations sovereignty in parallel to improved health outcomes for Aboriginal and Torres Strait Islander communities.

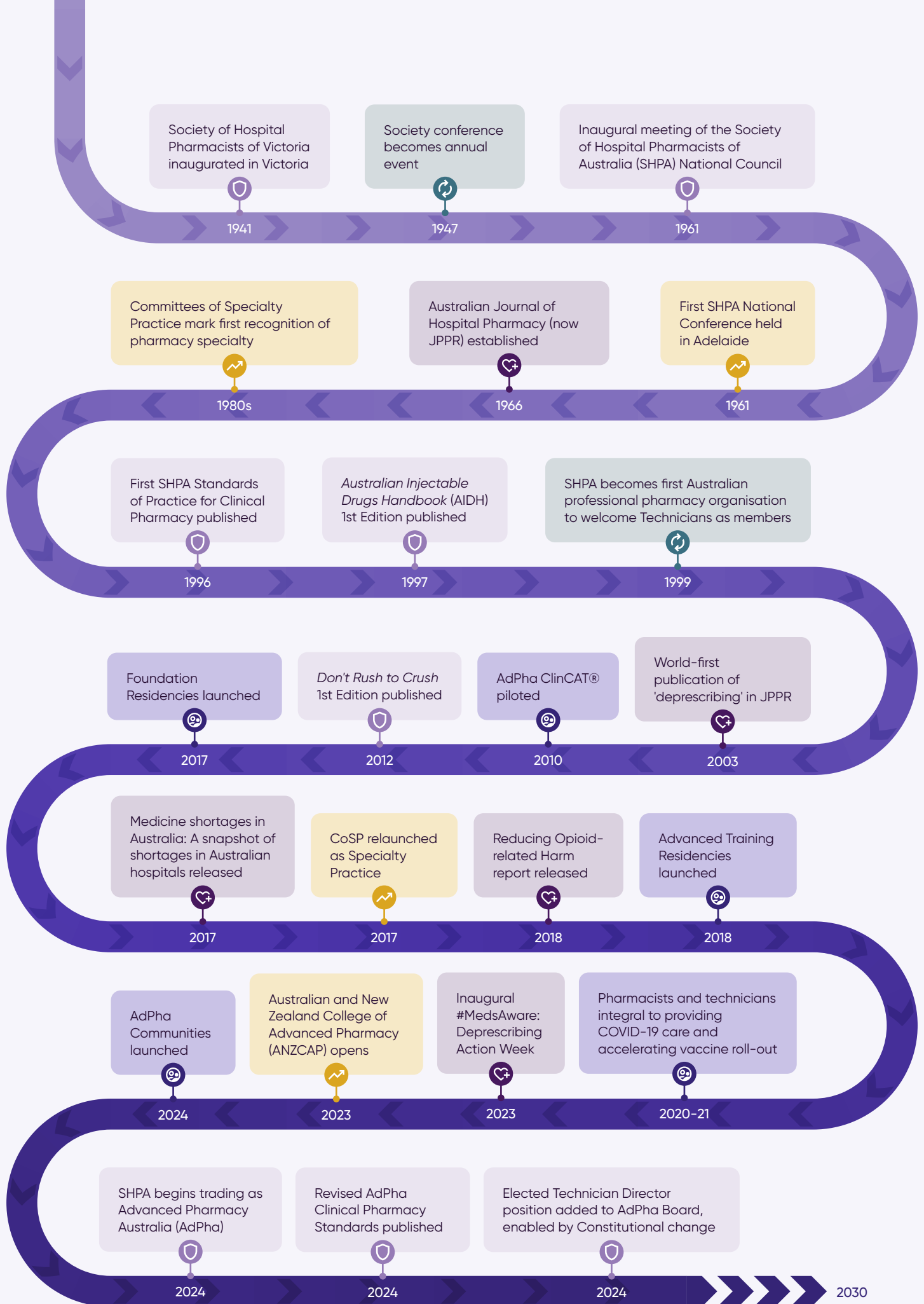

# Our forward vision

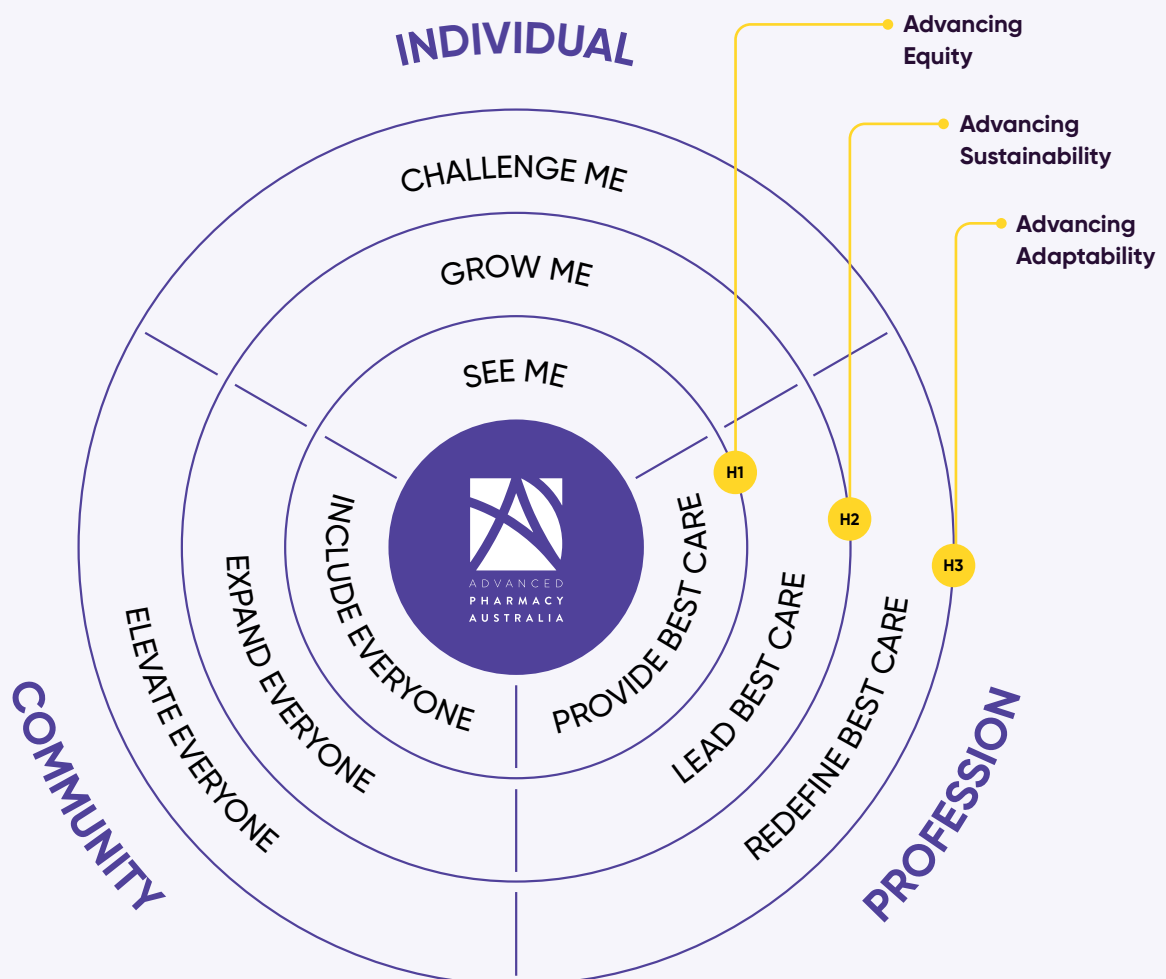
*Yindyamarra 2030* is the forward vision for Advanced Pharmacy Australia, spanning **three horizons**: Advancing Equity 2025–26, Advancing Sustainability 2027–28 and Advancing Adaptability 2029–2030.

Each horizon includes goals that will benefit three key stakeholder groups, the individual pharmacy practitioner, the profession in which they learn and grow and the community in which they live, work and provide care. As the horizons unfold, the influence and positive impact of Advanced Pharmacy Australia increases.

Progress toward the goals is underpinned by annual business plans that both influence and are responsive to the prevailing and developing policy landscape, i.e. the National Medicines Policy, Pharmaceutical Benefits Scheme, Medicare Benefits Schedule and National Health and Climate Strategy.

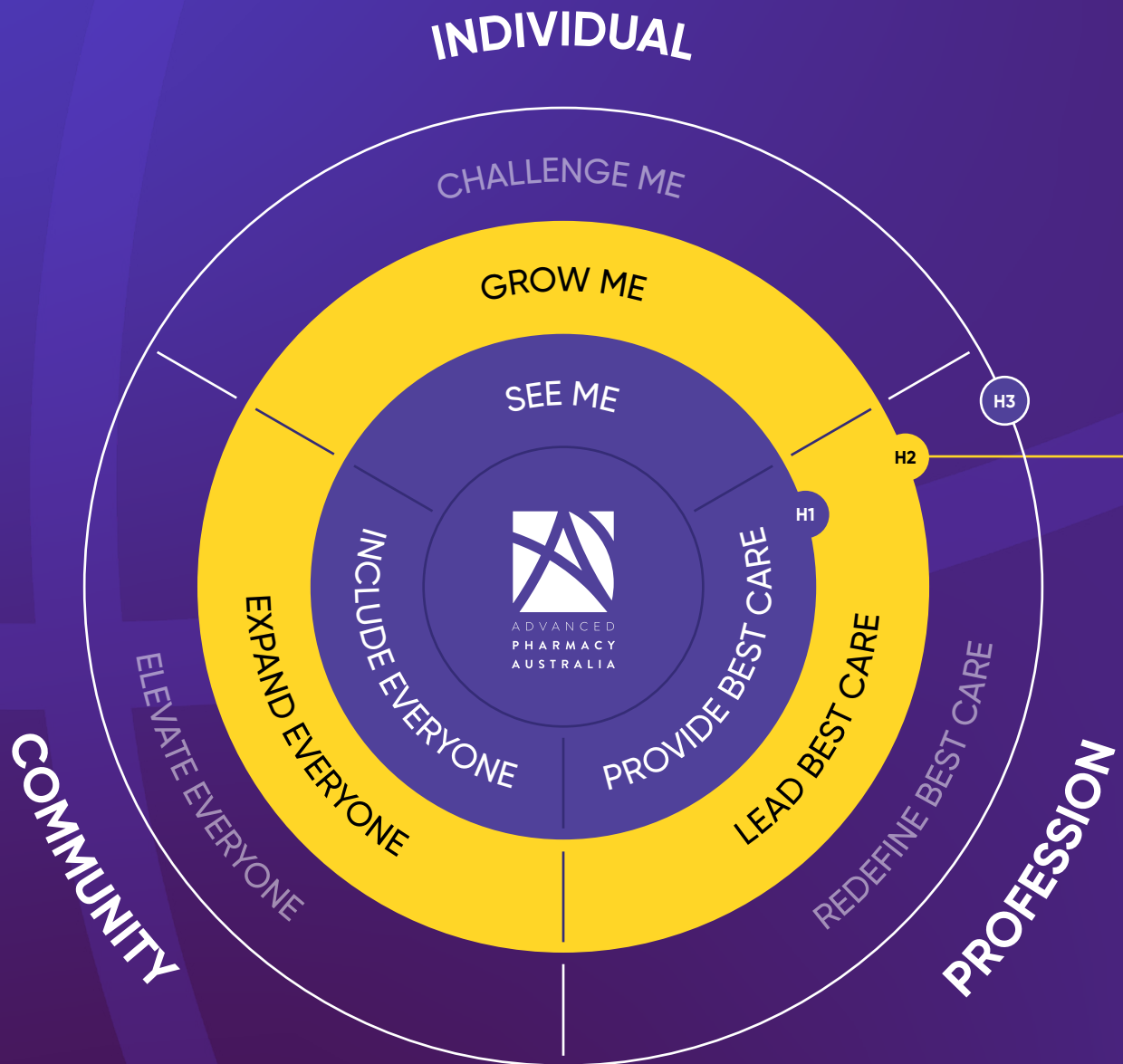

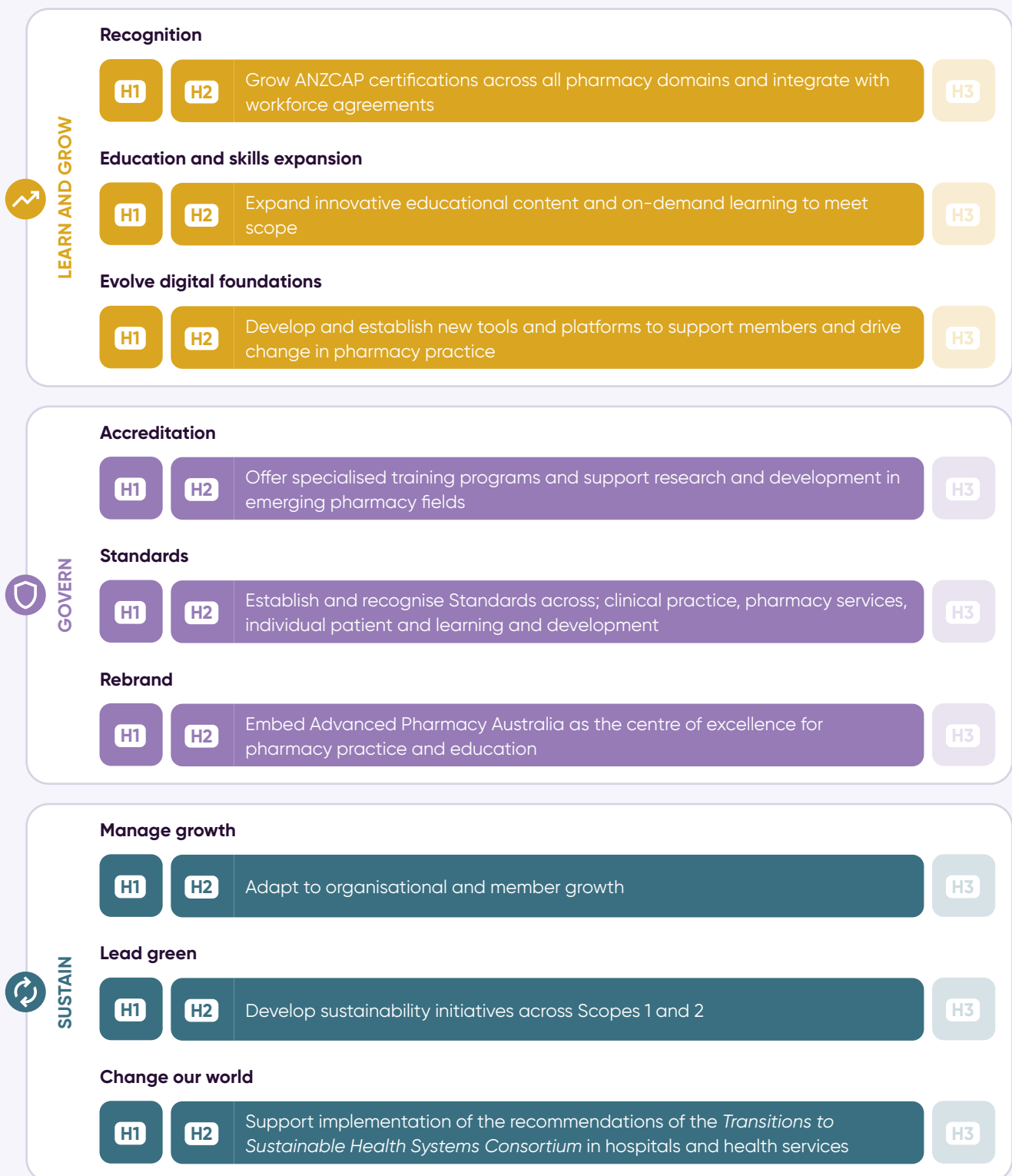
