

# Australian Clinical Pharmacy Award

The Australian Clinical Pharmacy Award (the Award) may be awarded annually to a member of the Advanced Pharmacy Australia (AdPha) in recognition of outstanding contributions in the area of clinical pharmacy practice.

#### **NOMINATIONS**

Nominations for the Award can be received annually from Branch Committees, Specialty Practice Groups, or a group of any three financial members of AdPha, submitting a recommendation.

Nominations will be called for annually. All nominees must be current and continuous members of AdPha for the past 5 years.

\*AdPha Membership is contiguous with SHPA Membership. If a member has been a member of SHPA for 5 years, this is considered the same/equivalent to AdPha membership for 5 years.

#### **NOMINATION PROCESS**

Nominations must be received via the nomination form available on the AdPha website by the advertised due date. The nomination process now consists of two stages:

Stage 1: Nomination submitted online from nominating group

• Branch Committee, Specialty Practice Groups, or any group of three (3) financial members of AdPha

Stage 2: Nominee will be notified of their nomination and required to provide the supporting documentation

- Acceptance of the nomination via checkbox in online process
- Two (2) signed letters in support of the nomination upload via online process
- A copy of the nominee's curriculum vitae (CV) maximum 8 pages

Nominations are valid without the need for additional applications, subject to acceptance from the nominee, for 2 years. Each valid year the standing nominees will be notified of their re-nomination by AdPha.

#### **SELECTION PANEL**

Nominations shall be considered by a selection panel chaired by the President of the AdPha. The composition of the selection panel shall be:

- The Board
- Recipients of Clinical Pharmacy Award from previous 2 years
- A Fellow

#### **CONFLICT OF INTEREST**

Selection panel members will be required to confirm acceptance to be on the selection panel and declare any conflict of interest.

In the event of such conflict of interest, the Chair of the selection panel is authorised to select a substitute panel member.

## **SELECTION CRITERIA**

The Australian Clinical Pharmacy Award shall be awarded to a member who has made an outstanding contribution in the field of clinical pharmacy practice. Such contribution may be made by academic achievement, professional leadership or national and international activity in clinical pharmacy, service to professional organisations (including AdPha), as well as other extra-mural activities, contribution to knowledge relating to clinical pharmacy practice or knowledge of therapeutics



through research, clinical teaching, service on expert panels/committees, or publications in peer-reviewed pharmacy/medical/scientific journals.

If, in the opinion of the Board of Directors, no nomination of sufficient merit is received in a particular year, they may recommend that the award not be made.

The Board of Directors shall have complete control of all matters pertaining to the conditions governing the Award and the selection of the recipient, and their decision on any matter shall be final.

## **VOTING**

If a member of the selection panel is nominated for the award, they shall recuse themselves from the panel, and may not participate in the voting process.

If a member of the panel has made one of the nominations or is a referee for a nomination, they shall not participate in the voting (see: **CONFLICT OF INTEREST**).

All nominations and supporting statements shall be sent to the panel members within approximately 15 days of the close of nominations. The selection panel members shall return ballots to the Chair via the Secretariat, indicating their first choice, before a deadline determined by the Secretariat. The candidate receiving a majority of votes shall be declared the award recipient.

If no candidate receives most of the votes on the first ballot, names of those receiving the highest number of votes shall be re-circulated and another vote taken. If one receives a majority, they shall be declared the recipient.

If only one nomination is received, AdPha Directors will be asked if they are satisfied the nominee has adequately met the award criteria and would be a worthy recipient of this award.

In the event of a tied vote, the casting vote will go to the President, or the Chair of the selection panel in the event of a Presidential Col.

The recipient of the Award shall be ratified by the Board of Directors.

#### PRESENTATION OF THE AWARD

The Award shall be presented at the annual Medicines Management Conference of AdPha.

The recipient will be financially supported to attend the Medicines Management Conference to accept their award with free conference registration, airfares, and accommodation.



The presentation of the Award shall be accompanied by the delivery of an oration by the recipient with subsequent publication by AdPha

# **REVIEW OF THE AWARD**

The terms and conditions of the award shall be subject to review every four years, or at the discretion of the Board of Directors.
