Pharmacy Intern Training at Monash Health:

- 13 Intern positions are available (11 Government plus 2 self-funded). All applications are made through the <u>AdPha Victorian Hospital Pharmacy Intern Program</u>.
- We provide a structured intern training program with orientation to each pharmacy practice area, learning objectives and assessments for each rotation.
- Monash Health offers high quality workplace learning:
 - o An emphasis on active learning
 - Intern pharmacists undertake the Monash University Intern Training Program.
 - Enrolment in the Monash University Intern Foundation Program is highly recommended and delivers a university higher qualification by the conclusion of the intern training year.
