Shortage of TIMOPTOL timolol maleate 0.5% eye drops bottle AUST R: 28775 and alternative supply arrangement under section 19A of the *Therapeutic Goods Act 1989*

The Australian registered medicine, **TIMOPTOL timolol maleate 0.5% eye drops bottle AUST R: 28775** sponsored by Mundipharma Pty Ltd is currently unavailable or in short supply.

LINK has been able to arrange supply of an alternative product **Timolol 0.5% w/v eye drops solution (Brown & Burk UK)** on a temporary basis. This product is NOT registered in Australia and supply is authorised under an approval granted by the Therapeutic Goods Administration (TGA) under section 19A of the *Therapeutic Goods Act 1989* until **30**th **June 2025** for the following indication(s):

Timolol is indicated for the reduction of elevated intraocular pressure. In clinical trials it has been shown to reduce intraocular pressure in:

- Patients with ocular hypertension
- Patients with chronic open-angle glaucoma
- Aphakic patients with glaucoma

Timolol 0.5% w/v eye drops solution (Brown & Burk UK) is registered and marketed in the United Kingdom and therefore all labelling is in English.

The approved s19A product and the Australian product are identical in active ingredient, strength, and formulation.

Please note the following information regarding differences between **Timolol 0.5% w/v eye drops** solution (Brown & Burk UK) and **TIMOPTOL timolol maleate 0.5% eye drops bottle AUST R: 28775**
