## Pharmacy students tune in as savings for essential resource announced

Beamed into screens around the country, the third annual SHPA-NAPSA Student Symposium concludes today with a difference after moving to an all-virtual event for 2020, as a new discount for students seeking to hone their smart search skills was also announced.

A joint venture of the Society of Hospital Pharmacists of Australia (SHPA) and the National Australian Pharmacy Students' Association (NAPSA), the 2020 Student Symposium featured a lead-in week of self-paced learning, with interactive webinar presentations rounding out the annual focus on individual professional development and the future shape of Australia's pharmacy workforce.

Upon opening the live component to a record number of delegates, SHPA Chief Executive Kristin Michaels noted the growing potential of virtual events.
